The V International Symposium on Fats and Oils: Trends and Innovation in Fats and Oils Technology will cover important subjects related to the Fats and Oils field, such as: processing, specialty fats, application, analysis, new technologies, as well as advances in scientific research.

The presentation of Scientific and Technical papers in the form of posters will occur during the 3 days of the event.

DEADLINE FOR PAPER SUBMISSIONS: AUGUST 2, 2010

RESPONSE TO AUTHORS: UNTIL AUGUST 16, 2010

There is no limit for presenting papers as co-authors. At least one of the authors must be registered in the symposium and must be present on the day and time of the presentation. Each registered presenting author can present a maximum of 3 papers.

The submission of papers in English, Spanish or Portuguese, with original scientific contributions, must follow the instructions below:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER PREPARATION:

Language: English, Spanish or Portuguese

Page format: size A4, with 3 cm margins, minimum 3 pages, maximum 6 pages

Font: Arial 11

Spacing: 1.5

Organization of the paper:

Title: in capitals, centralized

Author(s): centralized, authors' full names in capitals, beginning with the name of the main author. The name of the author that will present the work must be underlined. Names must

be separated by semicolons. By each name there must be a superscript number to identify the institution of origin.

Institutions: list only the name of the institution of origin, according to the list of authors.

Address: centralized, present the name of the institution where the research was carried out, including city, state, country, postal code and e-mail of the author to whom correspondence should be addressed.

Abstract: The abstract must have maximum 300 words, followed by up to 6 key-words.

Text: Must be written in continued text, in a summarized form, including the following sections: Introduction, with a short revision of literature and objectives; Experimental Procedure; Results and Discussion; Acknowledgments and References.

Introduction: Must be short and informative, with few key-references to guide the reader. Not more than 15 references will be permitted.

Experimental Procedure: Enough details of methods or literature references must be included to permit other authors to reproduce the experiment. This section must also present the method of analysis of the results.

Results and Discussion: Briefly describe the scientific results and the way in which they respond to the problem identified in the introduction. Tables and figures can be used, avoiding the repetition of results.

Acknowledgments: May be included, when pertinent.

References: References must be cited in parentheses in the text, in numerical and sequential order. At the end, they must be listed in the order they were cited. Use the rules recommended by the AOCS (*CASSI - Chemical Abstracts Service Source Index*) for a correct presentation, as in the examples below:
